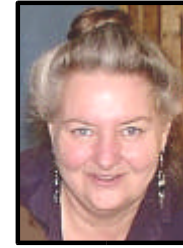

Many people question how we can afford the costs in social and financial terms. The Coalition and Callahan have received special awards for significant public education about drug war issues. Nora will be showing a **video, "Up on the Ridge"**, which is a one-hour television documentary produced by Nick Szuberla and Amelia Kirby of "Holler To The Hood". The program offers viewers an in-depth look at the United States prison industry and the social impact of moving hundreds of thousands of inner-city minority offenders to distant rural outposts. The film explores competing political agendas that align government policy with human rights violations, and political expediencies that bring communities into racial and cultural conflict with tragic consequences. Nora will lead a discussion after the film, with plenty of time for questions and answer.
